

CrossLife Church Reopening Phase 1 Guidelines

1. We cannot and will not prevent anyone from attending our services (unless they come with the intent to disrupt our services), but **the at-risk population**—defined as “those who are 65 and older, *especially* those with chronic lung disease; moderate to severe asthma; chronic heart disease; severe obesity; diabetes; chronic kidney disease undergoing dialysis; liver disease; or weakened immune system”—**is encouraged to stay home and participate with us online.**
2. Anyone who feels ill, is in questionable health, or has recently tested positive for COVID-19 should please stay home and participate with us online.
3. Our normal Sunday online broadcast will be offered as usual for those who are staying at home, and will continue to be offered with no plans for discontinuing.
4. A designated team of volunteers will disinfect any regularly touched surfaces, such as doorknobs, tables, chairs, and restrooms before and after worship. Hand sanitizer will also be readily available.
5. Greeters welcome members and guests outside the doors of the main entrance. Greeters will need to remind people of our facial mask and social distancing policy (posted in church also).
6. When we gather for in-person worship, 6’ social distancing area will be followed at all times. There will be no hugs or handshakes at this time.
7. The chairs in the worship area are set up to follow 6’ social distancing. Family members may sit next to each other but are asked to leave the existing chair arrangement intact as much as possible. Two individuals who are not members of the same household but who are attending together—e.g. good friends—may also sit next to each other if mutually agreed upon.
8. Attendees are **encouraged, but not required**, to wear cloth face coverings or non-medical grade face masks. Please plan to bring your own, but a limited number will be available at church.
9. The collection of the offerings will not take place during the service. There will be a designated area at the entrance to the worship area where people can drop their offering off or they can give on-line.
10. There will be no CrossKidz Bible Club, the kids will stay with their parents during the entire worship service, including the CrossTalk portion of the service.
11. The CrossTalk portion of the service will be shown via Zoom.
12. CrossKidz Message Notes will be prepared and available.
13. We will not have our usual fellowship snacks and coffee before or after worship.
14. The kitchen and all classrooms are off limits.
15. Those bringing guests along to church are earnestly asked to make those guests aware of these guidelines.
